Today we celebrate the birth of the Church with the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles. The Spirit of God has also made a home in each one of us, enabling us to be loving, forgiving, joyful and peaceful people. Difficulties and troubles will not be wanting in anyone's life, but the gift of the Spirit assures us that God's love and life are always with us

From the Pastor,

Today we bring the Easter season to a climactic end with the celebration of Pentecost. The Holy Spirit's descent upon the Apostles cowering in the upper room, inflaming them with a zeal to go out and tell the Good News is often seen as the birthday of the Church.

As we learn in the Acts of the Apostles, the Holy Spirit gave the Church an extraordinary push in the beginning. Thousands would convert upon hearing the Apostles preach and extraordinarily, even though the Apostles preached in their native Aramaic, every man and woman heard them in their own native tongue.

Despite being visible in His actions, the Holy Spirit remains the most mysterious of the Persons of the Trinity. He never says anything himself but rather inspires the voices of others to do His talking for Him. He is the greatest model of humility. His sole mission is to bring the world into union in the Father and the Son.

Anytime we celebrate a Sacrament it is the Holy Spirit that brings about the grace. This is most marvellously exemplified in the Mass, where the Holy Spirit enables the priest to act in the Person of Christ so that the bread and wine truly becomes the Body and Blood of Christ.

The Holy Spirit is not only present in the sacraments and big events but he is also behind every prayer we make, every good action we do, every smile, every kindness and every time we turn to God. On this great feast we can ask for the grace of knowing the Holy Spirit better as that will be a fast – track to trusting in God more.
