In trust and simplicity we hear the word of God. If we think we know it all, the word passes over us and we don't hear it. In the depths of our hearts, we are all equal. If we nestle in the heart of Jesus. we will come to know him and the Father too. Our souls will find refreshment and know the gentleness of the heart of God

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I have been in a particularly reflective mood this past week as I try to fathom the fact I have been a priest for ten years. I find that I oscillate between being amazed that it's already been ten years since my ordination to feeling amazed that it's only been ten years since ordination.

So much has happened and more importantly, there is so much to be grateful for. As I look back over the last decade what moves me the most is the sheer goodness of God. The priesthood has been an ever-deeper dive into the depths of God's love, understanding and care for humanity. This has firstly been through my experience of his mercy towards me. Our Lord is unrelentingly faithful and true even in the face of my own sins and failings. So many times I have wondered why he picked me when he could have gotten someone so much better. Celebrating the Mass, Baptisms, Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick are a privilege beyond words. It is so hard to describe the joy I feel being able to be the vessel through which God gives himself to his beloved children. I also am constantly moved as I look at newly wed couples God has joined together through me. Then, in addition to the sacraments, there are the graces that come from school, nursing home, house and hospital visits, chats with people seeking counsel or a sounding board and random encounters with strangers on the street. This leads me to you, God's people. Saint John Henry Newman once said that without the laity, priests would look very silly. I cannot thank God enough for the men, women and children I have met in the parishes and other apostolates I have been sent to. You have enriched and strengthened my faith. The welcome you have given me in your homes has grounded me and kept me real and most importantly, your prayers have helped me to persevere. Finally, I want to thank God for sending me to St Patrick's, Sutherland. I have

never felt so at home in a place. My time here has been an experience of learning what fatherhood in the priesthood is means. Like all dads, I am a work in progress and there is so much more to learn but I want to thank everyone from the parish staff through to the last parishioner for welcoming me and helping me to grow in this beautiful vocation. It is a privilege to be able to pray for you all at the altar and I treasure my time with you. May God bless you and keep you all safe in his peace. Please pray for me that I may grow in holiness and that I will be a much better priest.
