Hello.

I am the new face you see serving with Fr. Dan. My name is Julian Masiello, and I am a fifthyear seminarian. I have been living and studying at the Seminary of the Good Sheperd the last four years. Once a seminarian completes fourth year they get placed in a parish for pastoral work and so having just completed my fourth-year last month, I was put into the parish lucky dip and I hit the jackpot by being chosen to serve in your parish, St. Partick's Sutherland. Normally, it would be a six-month placement, but they have recently changed the requirements and I have been blessed to stay with you for a whole year! I thought it would be good to write a little about myself so that I am not a total stranger to you.

I spent the first half of my life growing up around Padstow/Revesby and so I am not far from being a local. After high school, my family moved to Annandale to be closer to the city for my older brother and I to go to university. I started discerning a potential vocation seriously which led me to leave my job to do missionary work with the Sisters of the Immaculata. After five months of missionary work with them, I returned surer of my vocation and took some vocational retreats. One of those retreats was at the seminary in Homebush and I am sure you know how this part of the story ends. I am now towards the end half of my formation in the seminary and so I hope to be more configured to Christ every day and a vessel of His love for you. 


